The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **H.B. 167**, ASSET FORFEITURE REVISIONS, by Representative B. Greene, be replaced with **2nd Sub. H.B. 167**, ASSET FORFEITURE REVISIONS, with the following amendments, and has returned it to the Rules Committee for further study by an interim committee.
