Mr. Speaker:

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 300**, FIREARM AND DANGEROUS WEAPONS AMENDMENTS, by Representative B. Greene, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 12:*

11 This bill:

2. *Page 3, Line 85 through Page 4, Line 91:*
