The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 364**, SUICIDE PREVENTION AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Eliason, with the following

1. *Page 4, Line 117 through Page 5, Line 121:*

117 (iv) covers the topics described in Subsection (2).

118 (b) (i) A school district shall annually offer one parent seminar for each 11,000  
students

119 enrolled in the school district.

**(ii) Notwithstanding Subsection (1)(b)(i), a school district may not be required to offer more than three seminars.**

120 (c) A school district may:

121 (i) develop its own curriculum for the seminar described in Subsection (1)(a); or

2. *Page 8, Lines 219 through 224:*

219 (1) expend appropriations under this section to implement the programs and training  
220 described in Section 53A-15-1301 addressing bullying and cyberbullying; and

221 (2) make up to ~~up to~~ {-\$1,000} \$1,500 available to each requesting school,  
for the school to choose a

222 program or training curriculum from a Utah-based organization that is tax exempt under

223 Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code, and that is focused on programs and training

224 addressing bullying and cyberbullying.
