The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.J.R. 6**, JOINT RULES RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR LEGISLATIVE TRAINING DAYS, by Representative J. Dunnigan, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 19 through 20:*

19 Special Clauses:

20        {~~None~~}        **This bill provides for retrospective operation.**

2. *Page 3, Lines 73 through 77:*

73        (3) Each committee may, {~~in~~} **for** a calendar year, authorize:

74        (a) up to four authorized legislative training days for a legislator; and

75        (b) up to two additional authorized legislative training days for a:

76        (i) legislator-elect; or

77        (ii) legislator who is in the first year of office.
