## Mr. President:

The Transportation and Public Utilities and Technology Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 50**, RAILROAD REVISIONS, by Senator K. Mayne, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 17:
  - provides definitions; <u>and</u>
  - prohibits {-a railroad} certain railroads from operating a freight train or light engine used in connection
  - with the movement of freight unless it has a crew consisting of at least two
  - 15 individuals {; and
  - 16 specifies the certification requirements for crew members operating a freight train or
  - 17 light engine used in connection with the movement of freight \ .
- 2. Page 2, Lines 29 through 30:
  - 29 (1) As used in this section, " { railroad } class I railroad " , "class II railroad", and "class III railroad" means the same as that term is defined in 49
  - 30 <u>U.S.C. Sec. 20102.</u>

- 3. Page 2, Lines 31 through 36:
  - 31 (2) A <u>class I railroad, class II railroad, or class III</u> railroad may not operate a freight train or light engine used in connection with
  - 32 <u>the movement of freight unless the railroad has a crew consisting of at least</u> { the following } two
  - 33 <u>individuals</u> {
  - 34 (a) a person who is certified as a locomotive engineer pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec.
  - 35 **20135**; and
  - 36 (b) a person who is certified as a conductor pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 20136} .
