**H.B. 372 Electrician Licensing Amendments (*Rep. D. McCay*)**

1 TITLE INSURANCE REPORTING AND ASSESSMENT AMENDMENTS

2. Page 1, Lines 12 through 13:

12 ▶ exempts an individual insurance producer, who is {not} an employee of a  
title insurer

13 or who is {not} designated by an agency title insurance producer, from certain title
