H.B. 145 Vulnerable Adult Worker Amendments (*Rep. D. Sanpei*)

Rep. Sanpei explained the bill assisted by Diane Moore, Director, Office of Licensing, and Alice Moffat, Director, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Identification.

MOTION: Rep. DiCaro moved to amend H.B. 145 as follows:

500 (i) for an annual renewal; or
501 (ii) when the office determines that reasonable cause exists;
502 (d) may submit an applicant's personal identifying information, including
fingerprints.
