Senator **Howard A. Stephenson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 131 through 141:*

- 131 (D) three units of credit of lab-based natural science; and
132 {+} (E) through the graduating class of 2019, two units of credit of sequential world or
classical language other than English;
133 and {+}
134 (ii) except as provided in Subsection (4), earns a course grade on a transcript of "C" or
135 above in each individual course listed in Subsection (1)(d)(i)[-]; and
136 (e) beginning with the graduating class of 2020, demonstrates at a minimum,
{novice} intermediate proficiency in a world language, as defined in
137 Section 53A-13-108.1, by:
138 (i) qualifying for {a} an intermediate or advanced biliterate proficiency seal described in
Section 53A-13-108.1;
139 (ii) completing the first {and} , second , and third year levels of the same world language,
as defined
140 in Section 53A-13-108.1, in grades 7 through 12; or
141 (iii) another means acceptable to the board.
