

S.B. 235

SCHOOL TURNAROUND AND LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT ACT

Senator **Aaron Osmond** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 19:*

19 ▶ directs the State Board of Education to:
= **• designate a district school or charter school as a low performing school, subject to certain**
criteria;

2. *Page 3, Lines 73 through 75:*

73 (6) "Low performing school" means a district school or charter school that :
(a) has received an "F" grade for three consecutive years under the school grading system;
= **(b) is in the**
74 lowest performing 3% of schools statewide according to points earned under the school grading
75 system {:-} ; and
(c) has been designated a low performing school by the board under Subsection 53A-1-1205(5).

3. *Page 6, Line 168:*

168 53A-1-1205. State Board of Education to **designate low performing schools and** identify
independent school turnaround

4. *Page 8, Line 232:*

232 board.
(5) (a) Subject to subsection (5)(b) and (c), the board may designate a district school or charter school
as a low performing school.
(b) The board may not designate a district school or charter school as a low performing school if the
district school or charter school does not meet the criteria described in Subsection 53A-1-1201(6)(a) and
(b).
(c) In designating a district school or charter school as a low performing school, the board shall consider
school performance information available under the PACE accountability system, adopted by the board.
