**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill requires an institution of higher education to provide certain information on organ donation.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ defines terms; and
- ▶ requires an institution of higher education to display certain information on the institution's website regarding organ donation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **53B-1-111** is enacted to read:

**53B-1-111. Organ donation notification.**

(1) As used in this section:



- 28           (a) "Donor" means the same as that term is defined in Section [26-28-102](#).
- 29           (b) "Donor registry" means the same as that term is defined in Section [26-28-102](#).
- 30           (c) "Institution of higher education" means an institution as described in Section
- 31 [53B-3-102](#).
- 32           (2) (a) An institution of higher education shall display, in accordance with Subsection
- 33 (2)(b):
- 34           (i) text notifying a student of the option to register as a donor by selecting the Internet
- 35 link described in Subsection (2)(a)(ii); and
- 36           (ii) an Internet link to a website for a donor registry established under Section
- 37 [26-28-120](#).
- 38           (b) Except as provided in Subsection (2)(c), an institution of higher education shall
- 39 display the information described in Subsections (2)(a)(i) and (ii) as a pop-up window on:
- 40           (i) an institutional web page on which a student registers for a course at least once
- 41 during the academic year; or
- 42           (ii) at least once each semester, quarter, or other applicable division of an academic
- 43 year, a secure Internet site that is customized for a student to access the individual student's
- 44 academic and other information.
- 45           (c) (i) An institution of higher education may provide the information described in
- 46 Subsections (2)(a)(i) and (ii) by other electronic means if the institution does not offer
- 47 Internet-based course registration or maintain a secure Internet site.
- 48           (ii) An institution of higher education described in Subsection (2)(c)(i) shall provide
- 49 the information by other electronic means at least twice per school year.
