General Description:
This bill modifies the Utah Criminal Code regarding the penalty for aggravated human
trafficking offenses involving a child.

This bill:
 changes the penalty for aggravated human trafficking from a first degree penalty to
a capital offense if the victim is 17 years old or younger and the offense results in
the death of the trafficked person; and
 prohibits the reduction of any sentence for the aggravated trafficking of a minor.

60	(1) An actor commits aggravated human trafficking for forced labor or forced sexual
61	exploitation or aggravated human smuggling if, in the course of committing a human
62	trafficking for forced labor or for forced sexual exploitation, a violation of Section 76-5-308, or
63	human smuggling offense under Section 76-5-308, the offense:
64	(a) results in the death of the trafficked or smuggled person;
65	(b) results in serious bodily injury of the trafficked or smuggled person;
66	(c) involves:
67	(i) rape under Section 76-5-402;
68	(ii) rape of a child under Section 76-5-402.1;
69	(iii) object rape under Section 76-5-402.2;
70	(iv) object rape of a child under Section 76-5-402.3;

83	(b) not accompanied by a family member who is 18 years of age or older.
84	(3) (a) Aggravated human trafficking is a first degree felony, except that a human
85	trafficking violation of Subsection (1)(a) is a capital felony if the victim is 17 years old or
86	younger.
87	(b) Aggravated human smuggling is a second degree felony.
88	(c) Aggravated human trafficking and aggravated human smuggling are each a separate
89	offense from any other crime committed in relationship to the commission of either of these
