**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill enacts provisions related to state longitudinal data.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ defines terms;
- ▶ provides that an individual may submit a request to the Utah Education and Telehealth Network to have data about the individual removed from the Utah Data Alliance; and
- ▶ directs the Utah Education and Telehealth Network to develop a web site that allows an individual to request removal of the individual's data from the Utah Data Alliance.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **53B-17-109** is enacted to read:

**53B-17-109. Utah Data Alliance -- Request for removal.**

(1) As used in this section, "Utah Data Alliance" means the longitudinal database housed in the Utah Education and Telehealth Network that contains de-identified data from:

- (a) the State Board of Education;
- (b) the State Board of Regents;
- (c) the Utah Education and Telehealth Network;
- (d) the Utah College of Applied Technology; and
- (e) the Department of Workforce Services.

(2) An individual owns a connected record about the individual contained in the Utah Data Alliance.

(3) An individual may request to have the individual's records removed from the Utah Data Alliance.

(4) If an individual submits a removal request described in Subsection (3), the Utah Education and Telehealth Network shall remove the individual's records from the Utah Data Alliance.

(5) The Utah Education and Telehealth Network shall develop an Internet website that allows an individual to submit the removal request described in Subsection (3).
