22	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, the Governor concurring therein:
23	WHEREAS, Lin-Manuel Miranda is the composer of "Hamilton," a critically acclaimed
24	hit musical that tells the story of America's Founding Fathers through hip hop music;
25	WHEREAS, "Hamilton" opened in 2015 and has smashed Broadway box office records
26	ever since, resulting in sold-out shows through 2016;

WHEREAS, the "Hamilton" soundtrack debuted at No. 12 on the Billboard album

28	charts and eventually went to No. 1 on the Rap Albums chart, making the musical accessible to
29	people who have not been able to see the staged performance, and resulting in one million
30	comments on Twitter in 2015 alone;
31	WHEREAS, Miranda has created something truly exceptional with the musical
32	"Hamilton" an experience that is captivating people worldwide, regardless of economic
33	circumstances and political differences;
34	WHEREAS, "Hamilton" tells the rich story of how our nation was miraculously built,
35	the product of the work of Founding Fathers who were brilliant, passionate, and deeply flawed
36	human beings;
37	WHEREAS, Miranda's play explains the timeless principles that founded America,
38	makes them current for modern audiences, and in doing so reaches audiences across all
39	spectrums;
40	WHEREAS, "Hamilton" deliberately cast actors of all races and ethnic backgrounds,
41	resulting in almost entirely minority cast, including a black Thomas Jefferson, Asian Eliza
42	Schuyler Hamilton, and Hispanic Miranda portraying the titular Alexander Hamilton himself;
43	WHEREAS, this casting decision has resulted in Americans of all races being able to
44	envision themselves as part of the American Revolution and the founding of our nation;
45	WHEREAS, Miranda has created a play that not only transformed the current landscape
46	of Broadway, but will have impacts on Americans and civic awareness for decades to come;
47	WHEREAS, Miranda was born in Manhattan, New York City, of Puerto Rican
48	ancestry, and graduated from Wesleyan University in 2002 where he studied performing arts
49	and particularly many genres of music, including freestyle rap, bodega, and salsa;
50	WHEREAS, before launching into the national consciousness with "Hamilton,"
51	Miranda taught high school English while writing his off-Broadway musical production "In the
52	Heights," which won the 2008 Tony Award for Best Musical and Best Original Score and the
53	2009 Grammy Award for Best Musical Theater Album, demonstrating his dedication to
54	students and learning;
55	WHEREAS, Miranda starred in his Broadway version of "In the Heights," earning a
56	2009 nomination for Tony Award for Best Actor in a Musical;
57	WHEREAS, the story of Alexander Hamilton's life captured Miranda's attention and
58	imagination after he read Pulitzer Prize winning author Ron Chernow's book "Alexander

59	Hamilton"; and
60	WHEREAS, Miranda has successfully integrated the musical arts, particularly rap, with
61	American history in a novel and creative approach for audiences in his own words, creating
62	"a story about America then, told by America now":
63	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the
64	Governor concurring therein, honors Lin-Manuel Miranda for his contributions to the arts and
65	to our shared vision that the history of the founding of the United States can and should be
66	taught and shared with all citizens.
67	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor encourage artists
68	in all mediums to use their talents and passions to continue to explore the rich, unique history
69	of America.
