The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 68**, POST-EXPOSURE BLOOD TESTING AMENDMENTS, by Representative E. Redd, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 16:*

to request a court order on behalf of an emergency services provider
authorizing a blood
- 15 sample from an individual if, during the course of performing the provider's duties,
