The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 300**, BODY-WORN CAMERAS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, by Representative D. McCay, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 137 through 139:*

137        (13) In determining whether a record is properly classified as private under  
            Subsection  
138        63G-2-302(2)(d), the governmental entity, State Records Committee, **local appeals**  
            **board,** or court shall consider

2. *Page 9, Lines 245 through 247:*
