Vice Chair Roberts called the meeting to order at 5:23 p.m.

**MOTION:** Rep. J. Peterson moved to approve the minutes of March 4, 2016, and March 7, 2016. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Daw, Rep. Eliason, and Rep. Tanner absent for the vote.

**S.B. 157S01 Pawnshop Amendments (*Sen. D. Thatcher*) (Rep. V. L. Snow)**

Sen. Thatcher explained the bill to the committee.

Spoke to the bill: Chief Tom Ross, Bountiful City Police Department, Utah Chiefs of Police Association

**MOTION:** Rep. Hollins moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Tanner absent for the vote.

**S.B. 205 Ethics Revisions (*Sen. R. Okerlund*) (Rep. K. McIff)**

Sen. Okerlund explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Redd moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ray and Rep. Tanner absent for the vote.

**S.B. 183 Department of Public Safety Amendments (Sen. C. Bramble) (Rep. D. Ipson)**

Rep. Ipson explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. McIff moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ray and Rep. Tanner absent for the vote.

**S.B. 248 Public Notice of Unclaimed Property (Sen. C. Bramble) (Rep. S. Eliason)**

Rep. Eliason explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. J. Peterson moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ray and Rep. Tanner absent for the vote.

**S.B. 234 Protecting Unborn Children Amendments (Sen. C. Bramble) (Rep. K. Stratton)**

Sen. Bramble explained the bill to the committee.

**MOTION:** Rep. Redd moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 3, Lines 59 through 61:*

59            (A) that substantial medical evidence from studies concludes that an unborn child  
              who  
60            is at least 20 weeks gestational age {is} may be capable of experiencing pain  
              during an abortion  
61            procedure; and

2. *Page 9, Lines 262 through 263:*

262            (i) substantial medical evidence from studies concluding that an unborn child who is  
              at  
263            least 20 weeks gestational age {is} may be capable of experiencing pain during  
              an abortion procedure;

The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Ray absent for the vote.



**MOTION:** Rep. Daw moved to hold the bill.
