BEEKEEPING MODIFICATIONS

Representative **Marc K. Roberts** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 17:*

- 11 This bill:
- 12 ▶ amends bee raising registration requirements; =
- ▶ addresses mosquito abatement district liability;
- 13 ▶ amends county bee inspector duties;
- 14 ▶ modifies inspection provisions;
- 15 ▶ provides for bee raising restrictions under certain circumstances;
- 16 ▶ prohibits a political subdivision from adopting an ordinance, rule, regulation, or
- 17 resolution prohibiting a property owner from establishing or maintaining ~~{an apiary}~~ certain
apiaries ;

2. *Page 3, Lines 63 through 64:*

- 63 registration on or before December 31 of each year. =
- (2) A mosquito abatement district, subject to the provisions of Chapter 2a, Part 7, Mosquito Abatement District Act, is not liable for damages to a beekeeper for bees damaged as a result of an aerosol spray applied to reduce a mosquito population.
- 64 ~~{(2)}~~ (3) (a) A person may not operate a wax-salvage plant without a license issued by the

- 178 4-11-18. Prohibition of beekeeping by a political subdivision.
- 179 ~~{A}~~ (1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), a political subdivision may not adopt an
ordinance, rule, regulation, or resolution
- 180 prohibiting a property owner from establishing or maintaining an apiary on the property
- 181 owner's property. =
- (2) A political subdivision may adopt an ordinance, rule, regulation, or resolution prohibiting a
person from locating an apiary of migratory bees within the boundaries of the political subdivision.
