BEE KEEPING AMENDMENTS

Representative **Kay L. McIff** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 4, Line 114 through Page 5, Line 121:*

114 (b) Application for a new registration to raise bees, or for an apiary location not subject
115 to renewal, shall be made to the department upon [~~tangible or electronic~~] forms prescribed and
116 furnished by the department, {~~within 30 days after~~} at least 14 days before the person:

117 (i) {~~takes possession of~~} locates the bees on a new site ; or

118 (ii) moves the bees into the state.

(c) The department shall respond to the applicant within seven days after receipt of the application.

119 {~~(c)~~} (d) A new commercial registration application may be filed at any time from January 1
120 through October 31, and shall include:

121 (i) the applicant's name and address;

2. *Page 7, Lines 204 through 205:*

204 (1) All registered commercial apiary locations shall consist of not less than {~~10~~} 20 colonies
205 of bees during a minimum of 60 out of 67 continuous days during any part of the season.
