INSURANCE MODIFICATIONS

Senator **Curtis S. Bramble** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 8 through 13:*

- 8 General Description:
9 This bill modifies insurance provisions related to payments and notices .
10 Highlighted Provisions:
11 This bill:
12 ▶ for certain payments made by mail, modifies the date on which the payment is
13 considered made to the date the payment is received {~~·~~} ; and
▶ addresses when certain notices to a policyholder are considered delivered.

2. *Page 3, Lines 73 through 78:*

- 73 ~~{(iii) If the notice required by this Subsection (2)(c) is sent by first-class mail, postage~~

3. *Page 8, Lines 222 through 223:*

- 222 (iii) for a payment that is made using the method described in Subsection (12)(a)(iii),
223 on the date the payment is made electronically.

(13) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, if under this section an insurer delivers one or more of the following by mail, the notice is considered delivered on the date the notice is received by the policyholder:

(a) notifies a policyholder of cancellation;

(b) notifies a policyholder of the intention not to renew; or

(c) offers or purports to renew a policy on less favorable terms or at higher rates.
