CHILD WELFARE MODIFICATIONS

Representative **Edward H. Redd** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 5, Lines 123 through 129:

- 123 (2) As part of the evidence-informed or evidence-based safety and risk assessments, the
124 division shall assess at least the following:
125 (a) threat ~~{of harm to a child}~~ to a child's safety ;
126 (b) protective capabilities of a ~~{child's parent or guardian}~~ parent or guardian, including the
parent or guardian's readiness, willingness, and ability to plan for the child's safety ;
127 (c) a child's particular vulnerabilities;
128 (d) interventions required to protect a child; and
129 (e) likelihood of future harm to a child.
