PROCUREMENT CODE MODIFICATIONS

Senator **Scott K. Jenkins** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 35, Lines 1056 through 1057:*

1056 (66) "Public funds" means money, regardless of its source, including from the federal
1057 government, that is owned {~~.~~} or held {~~.~~ or administered by a public entity} by a
procurement unit .

7. *Page 88, Lines 2719 through 2721:*

2719 (3) for a period of time exceeding 120 days, if the attorney general or the procurement
2720 unit's attorney determines in writing that the contract extension does not violate {~~this chapter or~~}
2721 state or federal antitrust laws and is consistent with the purpose of ensuring the fair and equitable
treatment of all persons who deal with the procurement system .
