21	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, the Governor concurring therein:
22	WHEREAS, every 11 minutes a child is born in the United States who will be
23	diagnosed with autism;
24	WHEREAS, as things stand today, those autistic children will spend the majority of
25	their lives as adults in a world of few opportunities;
26	WHEREAS, in the next four years, 200,000 people on the autism spectrum will turn 21,
27	which is the age at which federally mandated services end;
28	WHEREAS, those autistic adults will join the millions of adults with disabilities who
29	face decades-long waitlists for residential services, and little to no opportunity for employment

30 or social interaction; 31 WHEREAS, some adults on the autism spectrum need few, if any, supports, and we 32 continue to encourage their self-determination and independence; 33 WHEREAS, our attention is needed to acknowledge the many adults on the autism 34 spectrum who are navigating adulthood and wanting to reach their full potential; and 35 WHEREAS, autistic adults deserve access to the goals established by the Americans 36 With Disabilities Act, including equal opportunity, full participation, independent living, and 37 economic self-sufficiency: 38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the 39 Governor concurring therein, designates April 21 as "Autism After 21 Day." 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the state

legislatures of the other 49 states and members of Utah's congressional delegation.
