28 the Constitution of the United States; and 29 WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of our people -30 particularly for the generations to come – by proposing amendments to the Constitution of the 31 United States through a convention of the states under Article V for the purpose of restraining 32 these and related abuses of power: 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah 34 hereby applies to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United States, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to proposing amendments to the 35 36 Constitution of the United States that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit 37 the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and limit the terms of office for its 38 officials and for members of Congress. 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the President of 40 the United States Senate, Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, members of 41 Utah's congressional delegation, and the state legislators of the other 50 states, requesting their 42 cooperation. 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this joint resolution constitutes a continuing 44 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the 45 legislatures of at least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the same 46 subject.
