NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 6, 2017

Mr. President,

The Business and Labor Committee has returned **1st Sub. H.B. 97**, ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL OPERATIONS AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Eliason to the Rules Committee without recommendation and with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 15 through 17:
 - 15 creates and provides funding for the Operations Investigation Program to {-covertly
 - 16 <u>observe</u>} <u>engage in undisclosed observation</u> and evaluate customer contacts with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
 - 17 Control;
- 2. Page 8, Lines 229 through 239:
 - 229 {<u>(1) "Covert observation" or "covertly observe" means an act taken by the program to</u>
 - 230 <u>directly observe and evaluate the service offered by a subject store without the knowledge of</u>
 - 231 the subject store.
 - 232 (2) (1) "Interaction" means an individual act under the program to {covertly observe } engage in the undisclosed observation of a
 - 233 <u>subject store in a manner authorized by this part.</u>
 - 234 {-(3)} (2) "Program" means the Operations Investigation Program created







under Section 235 63J-4-703. (3) "Subject department" means the Department of Alcoholic 236 {-(4)-} Beverage Control. (4) "Subject store" means a store created under Title 32B, Chapter 237 $\{ \frac{-(5)}{-} \}$ 2, Part 5, State Store, by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission. 238 (5) "Undisclosed observation" means an act taken by the program to directly observe and evaluate the service offered by a subject store without the knowledge of the subject store. 239 Section 5. Section **63J-4-703** is enacted to read: 3. Page 9, Line 247: 247 (1) The executive director shall ensure that the program, through {-covert-} undisclosed observation, 4.
