The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 167**, PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN LICENSING ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. D. Hawkes, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

1. *Page 2, Lines 42 through 44:*

42           (ii) has been accepted in, and is successfully participating in, progressive resident

44 the applicant's second or third year of postgraduate training; and

2. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 49:*

45           (iii) has agreed to surrender to the division the applicant's license as a podiatric  
46 physician without any proceedings under Title 63G, Chapter 4, Administrative  
          Procedures Act,  
47 and has agreed the applicant's license as a podiatric physician will be automatically  
          revoked by  
48 the division if the applicant fails to continue in good standing in a {~~progressive~~
