Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 167**, PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN LICENSING ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative T. D. Hawkes, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 2, Lines 42 through 44:
  - 42 (ii) has been accepted in, and is successfully participating in, progressive resident
  - <u>43</u> training in a {<u>program approved by the</u>} <u>Council on Podiatric Medical Education</u> <u>approved program</u> within Utah, in
  - 44 the applicant's second or third year of postgraduate training; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 45 through 49:
  - 45 (iii) has agreed to surrender to the division the applicant's license as a podiatric
  - <u>46</u> <u>physician without any proceedings under Title 63G, Chapter 4, Administrative</u> <u>Procedures Act.</u>
  - <u>47</u> and has agreed the applicant's license as a podiatric physician will be automatically revoked by
  - <u>48</u> the division if the applicant fails to continue in good standing in a {<u>progressive</u> <u>resident training</u>
  - 49program approved by theCouncil on Podiatric Medical Educationapprovedprogressive resident training programwithin the state; and
