Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **H.B. 274**, HUMAN TRAFFICKING MODIFICATIONS, by Representative A. Romero, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 274**, HUMAN TRAFFICKING MODIFICATIONS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 8, Lines 213 through 220:*

- 213           (4) Unless otherwise provided by law or ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction  
214           to  
214           respond differently, a person who has received a vacatur of conviction under ~~{Section~~  
215           ~~78B-9-104(9)(f)}~~ Subsection 78B-9-108(2) , may respond to any inquiry as  
215           though the conviction did not occur.
- 216           (5) The bureau shall forward a copy of the order for vacatur to the Federal Bureau of  
217           Investigation.
- 218           (6) An agency receiving an order for vacatur shall ~~{delete}~~ expunge the  
218           petitioner's identifying  
219           information contained in records in the agency's possession relating to the incident for  
219           which  
220           vacatur is ordered.
