Mr. Speaker,

The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 422**, STATE FACILITIES AMENDMENTS, by Representative G. Froerer, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 14, Lines 415 through 421:
 - 415 (8) (a) The Legislature may not fund the [programming,] design[,] and construction of
 - 416 a new { building or } facility in phases over more than one year unless the Legislature { has
 - 417 approved each phase of the funding for the construction of the new building or facility by-} [the
 - 418 <u>affirmative</u>] <u>approves the funding for both the design and construction by</u> <u>a</u> vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house.
 - 419 {<u>(b) This Subsection (8) does not apply to an appropriation to fund a new</u> building or
 - 420 <u>facility's programming.</u> }

<u>(b) An agency is required to receive approval from the board before the</u> <u>agency begins programming for a new facility that requires legislative approval</u> <u>under Subsection (3).</u>

<u>(c) The board or an agency may fund the programming of a new facility</u> <u>before the Legislature makes an appropriation for the new facility under Subsection</u> (8)(a).
