Representative **Merrill F. Nelson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 14:*

11 This bill:

12 ▶ repeals the authority of the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice to make
13 rules related to evaluation criteria for the selection of judicial nominees; ~~{and}~~

▶ addresses evaluation criteria for the selection of judicial nominees; and

14 ▶ makes technical changes.

2. *Page 2, Lines 51 through 54:*

51 (2) In determining which of the applicants are the most qualified, the nominating

52 commissions shall determine by a majority vote of the commissioners present which of the

53 applicants best possess the ~~{ability, temperament, training, and experience}~~ legal knowledge and

ability, judicial temperament, training, professional experience, integrity, impartiality, work ethic,

financial responsibility, public service, and ability to perform the work of a judge. that qualifies them

54 for the office.
