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28	Section 1. Section 26-46-101 is amended to read:
29	26-46-101. Definitions.
30	As used in this chapter:
31	(1) "Committee" means the Utah Health Care Workforce Financial Assistance Program

33	[(1)] (2) "Geriatric professional" means [a person] an individual who is:

61	(1) There is created within the department the Utah Health Care Workforce Financial
62	Assistance Program to provide, within funding appropriated by the Legislature for [this
63	purpose] the following purposes:
64	(a) professional education scholarships and <u>education</u> loan repayment assistance to
65	health care professionals who locate or continue to practice in underserved areas; and
66	(b) education loan repayment assistance to geriatric professionals who locate or
67	continue to practice in underserved areas.
68	(2) Beginning with a contract entered into on or after May 8, 2018, the department may
69	enter into an education loan repayment assistance contract with a geriatric professional or a
70	health care professional who:
71	(a) practices in an underserved area; and
