Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 401**, HIGHER EDUCATION CRIMINAL BACKGROUND AMENDMENTS, by Representative V. K. Potter, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:
  - 13 This bill:
  - provides authorization to the Utah System of Technical Colleges Board of Trustees <u>and individual technical colleges</u>
  - 15 to require background checks for:
- 2. Page 4, Lines 106 through 109:

  - 107 <u>following individuals to submit to a fingerprint-based local, regional, and national</u> <u>criminal</u>
  - 108 <u>history background check and ongoing monitoring as a condition of employment:</u>
  - 109 (a) prospective employees { and volunteers } of technical colleges; and

3. Page 4, Lines 112 through 115:

- 112 (3) Beginning July 1, 2018, the board of {<u>trustees shall</u>} <u>directors may</u> require a fingerprint-based local,
- 113 regional, and national criminal history background check without ongoing monitoring as a
- 114 <u>condition of enrollment for student applicants who are under consideration for training</u>
- 115 programs:







## 4. Page 4, Line 120 through Page 5, Line 123:

- 120 (5) The board of {<u>trustees</u>} <u>directors</u> shall require that an individual required to submit to a
- 121 <u>background check under Subsections (3) and (4) provide a signed waiver to the technical</u>
- 122 <u>college on a form provided by the board of</u> {<u>trustees</u>} <u>directors</u> that meets the requirements of Subsection
- 123 <u>53-10-108(4).</u>
