The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 468**, RESIDENTIAL VOCATIONAL AND LIFE SKILLS PROGRAM AMENDMENTS, by Representative P. Ray, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 125 through 126:*

125 (e) the name and residential address of any officer, director, ~~{owner,}~~
manager, or
126 administrator of the residential, vocational and life skills program;

2. *Page 5, Lines 130 through 132:*

130 (g) a disclosure indicating whether any officer, director, ~~{owner,}~~ or
administrator of the
131 residential, vocational and life skills program has been the subject of an administrative
action
132 by the division;

3. *Page 5, Lines 133 through 135:*

133 (h) a disclosure indicating whether any officer, director, ~~{owner,}~~ or
administrator of the
134 residential, vocational and life skills program has been convicted of a felony or a crime of

135 moral turpitude within the previous 10 years;

4. *Page 5, Line 150 through Page 6, Line 159:*
