The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **S.B. 91**, ANIMAL WELFARE AMENDMENTS, by Senator G. Davis, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 91**, ANIMAL WELFARE AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Line 81 through 84:
 - 81 (h) (i) "Shelter," as the term relates to an animal other than a dog or cat, means
 in counties of the first class, natural
 - 82 or artificial protection against inclement weather and direct sunlight.
 - 83 (ii) "Shelter," as it relates to a dog or cat, means , in counties of the first class, a barn, dog house, or other enclosed
 - 84 structure that:
- 2. Page 4, Line 94 through 96:
 - 94 (iii) "Shelter" does not include , in counties of the first class :
 - 95 (A) a crawl space;
 - 96 (B) the space under a vehicle;
- 3. Page 4, Line 112 through 114:
