

S.B. 55

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION AMENDMENTS

Senator **Wayne A. Harper** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 15a*

Senate Committee Amendments

1-25-2018:

- 12 This bill:
- 13 ▶ requires a waiver of a fine for a violation for failure to display ~~§~~→ a license plate or ~~←~~§
- 13a registration decals if:
- 14 • the vehicle was properly registered at the time of the citation; and
- 15 • the person cited provides evidence , within 21 business days, that the ~~§~~→ license
plate and ~~←~~§ decals have
- 15a been properly displayed {~~.~~} ; and
▶ allows a year decal to be displayed over or in place of the previous year sticker.

2. *Page 3, Line 82 through Page 4, Line 91:*

- 82 (8) The current year decal issued in accordance with Subsection (5) shall be placed
- 83 over or in place of the previous year decal.
- 84 (9) If a license plate, month decal, or year decal is lost or destroyed, a replacement shall
- 85 be issued upon application and payment of the fees required under Section 41-1a-1211 or
- 86 41-1a-1212.
- 87 (10) (a) A violation of this section is an infraction.
- 88 (b) A court shall waive a fine for a violation under this section if:
- 89 (i) the registration for the vehicle was current at the time of the citation; and
- 90 (ii) the person to whom the citation was issued provides , within 21 business days, evidence that
the ~~§~~→ license plate
- 90a and ~~←~~§ decals are
- 91 properly displayed in compliance with this section.
