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7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9           This bill requires an electrical corporation to provide each nonresidential customer  
10 online access to usage data in certain circumstances.

11 **Highlighted Provisions:**

12           This bill:

- 13           ▶ if available and requested by the customer, requires an electrical corporation to  
14 provide the nonresidential customer access to the customer's usage data in:
- 15           • 15 minute intervals; or
  - 16           • the shortest requested interval available through existing meters; and
- 17           ▶ allows the electrical corporation to charge the customer the costs associated with  
18 providing the usage data to the customer.

25           **54-3-2**, as last amended by Laws of Utah 1996, Chapter 170

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27 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

28           Section 1. Section **54-3-2** is amended to read:

29           **54-3-2. Schedules of rates and classification -- Right of inspection -- Changes by**  
30 **commission -- Online consumer access to usage data.**

31           (1) Under the rules and regulations made by the commission, [~~every~~] each public  
32 utility, shall file with the commission within the time and in the form as the commission may  
33 designate, and shall print and keep open to public inspection, schedules showing all rates, tolls,  
34 rentals, charges, and classifications collected or enforced, or to be collected or enforced,  
35 together with all rules, regulations, contracts, privileges, and facilities which in any manner  
36 affect or relate to rates, tolls, rentals, charges, classifications, or service.

37           (2) Except for motor carriers exempted under federal law, nothing in this section shall  
38 prevent the commission from approving or fixing rates, tolls, rentals, or charges from time to  
39 time greater, or less, than those shown by the schedules.

40           (3) The commission shall have power, in its discretion, to determine and prescribe, by  
41 order, changes in the form of the schedules referred to in this section as it may find expedient,  
42 and to modify the requirements of any of its orders or rules or regulations in respect to any  
43 matters described in this section.

44           (4) (a) If requested by a nonresidential customer, and to the extent available through  
45 existing meters, each electrical corporation shall provide the nonresidential customer access to  
46 the customer's usage data.

47           (b) Each electrical corporation shall provide the access described in Subsection (4)(a)  
48 broken down into:

49           (i) 15 minute intervals; or

50           (ii) the shortest requested interval available through existing meters.

51           (c) If incremental costs are associated with providing the access described in this  
52 Subsection (4), the electrical corporation may charge the customer an amount determined by  
53 the electrical corporation's governing authority, as defined in Section [54-15-102](#).
