| 12 | General Description: |
| 13 | This concurrent resolution encourages purchase of Tier 3 compliant gasoline. |
| 14 | Highlighted Provisions: |
| 15 | This resolution: |
| 16 | recognizes impacts of air quality on the state; |
| 17 | recognizes impact of vehicle emissions on air quality; |
| 18 | recognizes that the lower-sulfur Tier 3 gasoline standards are crucial to improving |
| 19 | the safety, health, and welfare of Utah's citizens; |
| 20 | recognizes that certain local refineries have committed to manufacturing Tier 3 |
| 21 | compliant lower-sulfur gasoline for sale in Utah; |
| 22 | acknowledges the air quality benefits that come from burning lower-sulfur gasoline |
| 23 | in vehicles; |
| 24 | acknowledges that the state is providing certain tax benefits for refineries |
| 25 | manufacturing lower-sulfur gasoline; and |
| 26 | • encourages purchase of lower-sulfur Tier 3 compliant gasoline by retailers and |
| 27 | consumers. |

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| 3031 | Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, the Governor concurring therein: |
| 32 | WHEREAS, the Legislature of the state of Utah is charged with protecting and |
| 33 | enhancing the safety, health, and welfare of its citizens; |
| 34 | WHEREAS, the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of the state of Utah are |
| 35 | profoundly affected by its air quality; |
| 36 | WHEREAS, communities along the Wasatch Front and other areas in the state of Utah |
| 37 | experience episodic and sustained periods of time where air pollutants are elevated to levels |
| 38 | that are known to cause serious short- and long-term health problems in humans; |
| 39 | WHEREAS, there are indications that air quality may impact the ability to recruit and |
| 40 | retain businesses and a high quality labor force, as well as the cost of negative health impacts |
| 41 | and the loss of tourism and recreational revenue, air quality significantly impacts the economy |
| 42 | of the state of Utah; |
| 43 | WHEREAS, vehicle emissions are the largest contributing source of total emissions |
| 44 | and contribute significantly to the buildup of air pollutants during wintertime inversions; |
| 45 | WHEREAS, national standards exist for improved vehicle emissions and gasoline, |
| 46 | called Tier 3 standards, bringing down the sulfur content of gasoline from 30 parts per million |
| 47 | to 10 parts per million; |
| 48 | WHEREAS, burning lower-sulfur Tier 3 gasoline in vehicles greatly improves the |
| 49 | effectiveness of a vehicle's catalytic converter; |
| 50 | WHEREAS, burning lower-sulfur Tier 3 gasoline will significantly reduce vehicle |
| 51 | emissions of nitrogen oxides and volatile organic compounds, pollutants that are significant |
| 52 | contributors to poor air quality in the state of Utah; |
| 53 | WHEREAS, some of Utah's local refineries have committed to manufacturing gasoline |
| 54 | for sale in Utah with an average sulfur level of 10 parts per million or less; |
| 55 | WHEREAS, lower-sulfur Tier 3 gasoline is manufactured by at least one local refinery, |
| 56 | Silver Eagle Refinery, and other local refineries have committed to manufacture Tier 3 gasoline |

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| 57 | for purchase, including Marathon Petroleum and Chevron, and other refineries are encouraged |
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| 58 | to manufacture Tier 3 gasoline; |
| 59 | WHEREAS, many gasoline retailers have the option to purchase gasoline from the |
| 60 | refineries that have committed to manufacturing cleaner burning Tier 3 gasoline; |
| 61 | WHEREAS, there have been measurable improvements in air quality because of |
| 62 | sustained efforts made by individuals and industry throughout the state; and |
| 63 | WHEREAS, the state of Utah is providing certain tax benefits to refineries that |
| 64 | manufacture lower-sulfur Tier 3 compliant gasoline: |
| 65 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the |
| 66 | Governor concurring therein, encourages gasoline retailers to purchase gasoline from refineries |
| 67 | that manufacture Tier 3 compliant gasoline with an average sulfur content of 10 parts per |
| 68 | million or less. |
| 69 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor encourage |
| 70 | citizens of the state to purchase gasoline at retailers whose supply comes from refineries |
| 71 | manufacturing Tier 3 compliant gasoline. |
