26	41-1a-404. Location and position of plates Visibility of plates Exceptions.
27	(1) License plates issued for a vehicle other than a motorcycle, trailer, or semitrailer
28	shall be attached to the vehicle, one in the front and the other in the rear.
29	(2) The license plate issued for a motorcycle, trailer, or semitrailer shall be attached to
30	the rear of the motorcycle, trailer, or semitrailer.
31	(3) Except as provided in Subsection (5), a license plate shall at all times be:
32	(a) securely fastened:
33	(i) in a horizontal position to the vehicle for which it is issued to prevent the plate from
34	swinging;
35	(ii) at a height of not less than 12 inches from the ground, measuring from the bottom
36	of the plate; and
37	(iii) in a place and position to be clearly visible; and
38	(b) maintained:
39	(i) free from foreign materials; and
40	(ii) in a condition to be clearly legible.
41	(4) Enforcement by a state or local law enforcement officer of the requirement under
42	Subsection (1) to attach a license plate to the front of a vehicle shall be only as a secondary
43	action when the vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation by any person in the
14	vehicle of Title 41, Motor Vehicles, other than:
45	(a) the requirement under Subsection (1) to attach a license plate to the front of the
46	vehicle[, or for another offense.];
1 7	(b) a parking violation under Section 41-6a-1401; or
48	(c) a violation of a parking ordinance of a political subdivision.
1 9	(5) The provisions of Subsections (3)(a)(iii) and (3)(b) do not apply to a license plate
50	that is obscured exclusively by one or more of the following devices or by the cargo the device
51	is carrying, if the device is installed according to manufacturer specifications or generally
52	accepted installation practices:
53	(a) a trailer hitch;
54	(b) a wheelchair lift or wheelchair carrier;
55	(c) a trailer being towed by the vehicle;
56	(d) a bicycle rack, ski rack, or luggage rack; or

- (e) a similar cargo carrying device.
- 58 (6) A violation of this section is an infraction.
