Section 1. Section **53G-7-217** is enacted to read:

53G-7-217. Local education agency Medicaid reimbursements.

{(1) }Beginning January 1, 2021, {and except as provided in Subsection (2), an LEA

may not receive a Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs as allowed by the Medicaid

program.

(2) On}the state board may, on behalf of an LEA {, the state board shall}:

(<u>{a}1</u>) enter into an agreement for Medicaid reimbursement for administrative costs;

and

(<del>{b}</del><u>2</u>) submit administrative reimbursement requests as allowed by the Medicaid program.
