AMENDS:

78A-1-103, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2018, Chapter 97

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **78A-1-103** is amended to read:

78A-1-103. Number of district judges.

The number of district court judges shall be:

- (1) four district judges in the First District;
- (2) 14 district judges in the Second District;
- (3) [29] 31 district judges in the Third District;
- (4) 13 district judges in the Fourth District;
- (5) six district judges in the Fifth District;

- 30 (6) two district judges in the Sixth District;
- 31 (7) three district judges in the Seventh District; and
- 32 (8) three district judges in the Eighth District.
