8 **General Description:**

9 This bill establishes the Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission.

10 **Highlighted Provisions:**

11 This bill:

- 12 ▶ defines terms;
- 13 ▶ establishes the Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission

14 (commission); and

- 15 ▶ requires the commission to:

- 16 • explore the need for and estimate the cost of implementing human trafficking
- 17 prevention education; and

- 18 • report to the Legislature's Education Interim Committee and the Executive
- 19 Appropriations Committee.

35 Section 1. Section **63C-21-101** is enacted to read:

36 **CHAPTER 21. HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION EDUCATION**

37 **COMMISSION**

38 **Part 1. General Provisions**

39 **63C-21-101. Title.**

40 This chapter is known as "Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission."

41 Section 2. Section **63C-21-102** is enacted to read:

42 **63C-21-102. Definitions.**

43 As used in this chapter, "commission" means the Human Trafficking Prevention  
44 Education Commission created in Section **63C-21-201** to aid public school teachers, parents,  
45 and educators to learn the signs of human trafficking in student populations.

46 Section 3. Section **63C-21-201** is enacted to read:

47 **Part 2. Commission Creation and Duties**

48 **63C-21-201. Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission creation --**

49 **Members.**

50 (1) There is created the Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission.

51 (2) The commission is composed of the following nine members:

52 (a) one member of the House of Representatives whom the speaker of the House of  
53 Representatives appoints;

54 (b) one member of the Senate whom the president of the Senate appoints;

55 (c) one individual who represents the Utah Public Education System and whom the  
56 chair of the State Board of Education appoints;

57 (d) one individual who represents the Division of Child and Family Services and whom  
58 the executive director of the Department of Health appoints; and

59 (e) the following five individuals whom the attorney general appoints:

60 (i) one individual who represents the Office of the Attorney General;

61 (ii) one member of the Utah Trafficking in Persons Task Force;

62 (iii) one individual who represents a Children's Justice Center established under

63 Section [67-5b-102](#); and

64 (iv) two members of the public at large.

65 (3) (a) The commission member who represents the Office of the Attorney General  
66 shall serve as the commission chair.

67 (b) The commission chair shall set the agenda for commission meetings.

68 (4) (a) A simple majority of the members of the commission constitutes a quorum for  
69 the transaction of commission business.

70 (b) Formal commission action requires a majority vote of a quorum of the commission.

71 (5) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (5)(b), a commission member may not receive  
72 compensation, benefits, per diem, or travel expenses for the member's service.

73 (b) Compensation and expenses of a commission member who is a legislator are  
74 governed by Section [36-2-2](#) and Legislative Joint Rules, Title 5, Legislative Compensation and  
75 Expenses.

76 (6) The Office of the Attorney General shall provide staff support to the commission.

77 Section 4. Section **63C-21-202** is enacted to read:

78 **63C-21-202. Commission duties.**

79 (1) The commission shall:

80 (a) explore the need for human trafficking prevention education; and

81 (b) estimate the cost of implementation of the needed human trafficking prevention  
82 education that the commission identifies under Subsection (1)(a).

83 (2) The commission may conduct other business related to human trafficking  
84 prevention education in Utah schools.

85 (3) The commission shall report to the Legislature's Education Interim Committee and  
86 the Executive Appropriations Committee before December 2019, regarding:

87 (a) the commission's performance of the commission's duties; and

88 (b) recommendations for future legislation related to human trafficking prevention  
89 education.

90 Section 5. Section **63I-2-263** is amended to read:

91 **63I-2-263. Repeal dates, Title 63A to Title 63N.**

92 (1) On July 1, 2020:

93 (a) Subsection **63A-3-403(5)(a)(i)** is repealed; and

94 (b) in Subsection **63A-3-403(5)(a)(ii)**, the language that states "appointed on or after  
95 May 8, 2018," is repealed.

96 (2) Title 63C, Chapter 19, Higher Education Strategic Planning Commission is  
97 repealed July 1, 2020.

98 (3) Title 63C, Chapter 21, Human Trafficking Prevention Education Commission, is  
99 repealed July 1, 2020.
