The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **1st Sub. H.B. 15**, VICTIM RIGHTS AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Eliason, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 15**, VICTIM RIGHTS AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 83 through 86:
 - 83 (a) { Subject to Subsection (d), within } Within 30 days of receiving a request from an individual
 - 84 who is a victim of a first degree felony, or who is a family member of a missing person or
 - 85 <u>homicide victim, to accept a transferred investigation, the attorney general shall request</u> from
 - 86 the law enforcement agency all evidence and information regarding the investigation.
