The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 398**, SUBSTANCE USE AND HEALTH CARE AMENDMENTS, by Representative B. M. Daw, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 29 through 31:
 - 29 Other Special Clauses:
 - 30 \{\text{None}\} \text{This bill provides a special effective date.}
 - 31 Utah Code Sections Affected:
- 2. Page 8, Line 243 through Page 9, Line 247:
 - 243 (2) A practitioner may dispense methadone at an opioid treatment program regardless
 - of whether the practitioner is licensed to dispense methadone under this chapter if the practitioner:
 - 245 (a) { the practitioner } is operating under the direction of a { pharmacist; and } physician;
 - (b) dispenses the methadone under the direction of a pharmacist; and
 - 246 (c) acts in accordance with division rule.
 - 247 (3) The division shall, in consultation with pharmacies, physicians, and practitioners
- 3. Page 14, Lines 421 through 424:
 - 421 (1) a physician from a community-based health care facility that specializes in women's
 - 422 <u>health;</u> {<u>and</u>}

(m) a representative from the Department of Corrections; and

- 423 (m) other stakeholders, as determined by the commission.
- 424 (4) The committee shall:
- 4. Page 16, Lines 484 through 485:
 - 484 Committee and the Utah Substance Use and Mental Health Advisory Council before November

Section 9. Effective date.

<u>The amendments to Sections 58-1-111 and 59-10-1111 take effect for a taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2020.</u>
