The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 7**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE ECONOMIC IMPORTANCE OF OUTDOOR RECREATION FOR UTAH, by Representative R.  - 32 spectacular National Parks;
