The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.C.R. 15**, CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE GOLDEN SPIKE, by Representative J. Ferry, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 56 through Page 3, Line 59:
  - 56 in Promontory Summit, Utah, and have protected and preserved the site for future generations.

<u>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor</u>
<u>authorize the Spike 150 Commission to create a spike using native Utah copper. This</u>
spike shall officially be known as the "Utah Spike."

- **commemorates** the 150th anniversary of the Golden Spike ceremony and the completion of the
- 59 transcontinental railroad.
