Representative **Karen Kwan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 4, Lines 99 through 106:*

- 99 (e) four representatives of first responders appointed by the chair, one of whom is a
100 voting member of the employee side of the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council;
101 (f) one representative from the Utah League of Cities and Towns; =
 (g) one representative from the Utah Association of Counties;
102 {(g)} **(h)** one representative from the Utah Association of Special Districts;
103 {(h)} **(i)** the director of the Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health, or the director's
104 designee; and
105 {(i)} **(j)** as appointed by the chair, one or more individuals with expertise in mental stress or
106 occupational medicine to serve as ex officio, nonvoting members of the workgroup.

2. *Page 5, Lines 127 through 132:*

- 127 (7) The workgroup shall present a final report on the items described in Subsection (6),
128 including any legislative recommendations, to the Business and Labor Interim Committee on or
129 before September 30, {2019} **2020** .
