Representative **Timothy D. Hawkes** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 49 through 52:
 - WHEREAS, the current trajectory suggests there is a {-very} real and near-term risk of
 - significant and irreversible impacts to the health of Great Salt Lake and its wetlands, which
 - also poses a threat to Utah's economy, public health and welfare, air quality, environmental
 - resources, and the ability to provide water to meet Utah's growing economy;
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 56 through 58:*
 - 56 WHEREAS, Great Salt Lake and its ecosystem could face a similar fate due to {-a
 - 57 combination of historic {-and current} water management practices {-and-} diversions, drought and
 - variable climatic conditions; and
- 3. Page 3, Lines 68 through 72:
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor encourage the
 - 69 Departments of Natural Resources and Environmental Quality through their relevant divisions {-
 - 70 along with the Great Salt Lake Advisory Council, to expeditiously, jointly, and collaboratively
 - 71 engage with a wide-range of stakeholders to develop recommendations for policy and other
 - solutions to ensure adequate water flows to Great Salt Lake and its wetlands.
