Senator **Deidre M. Henderson** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 77 through 78:
 - 77 (2) "Event" means a single, specific occurrence of { a concert, game, performance, show,
 - <u>one of the following, that takes place at a venue:</u>
 - (a) a concert;
 - (b) a game;
 - (c) a performance;
 - (d) a show; or
 - (e) an occasion similar to the occasions described in Subsections (2)(a) through (d).
- 2. Page 4, Lines 91 through 92:
 - 91 person who issued the ticket or the person's agent or operator.
 - (6) (a) "Venue" means real property located in the state where one or more persons host a concert, game, performance, show, or similar occasion.
 - (b) "Venue" includes an arena, a stadium, a theater, a concert hall, an amphitheater, a fairground, a club, a convention center, a public assembly facility, or a mass gathering location.

- 3. Page 5, Lines 132 through 142:
 - 132 13-54-302. Reporting.
 - 133 {On July 15, 2020, and January 15 and July 15 of each year thereafter, each person who
 - 134 is subject to the provisions of this chapter shall submit a report to the division that contains the
 - 135 following information for the six months preceding the day on which the person submits the
 - 136 report:
 - (1) the number of transferrable tickets the person issued;
 - 138 (2) the number of restricted tickets the person issued;
 - 139 (3) the number of scheduled concert and theater events for which the person issued
 - 140 tickets; and
 - (4) the number of events for which the person issued restricted tickets under
 - 142 **Subsection 13-54-201(2)(b).**
 - (1) As used in this section, "reporting period" means:
 - (a) for a report submitted under this section in compliance with a July 15 deadline, January 1 through June 30 of the calendar year in which the report is submitted; or

- (b) for a report submitted under this section in compliance with a January 15 deadline, July 1 through December 31 of the calendar year immediately preceding the calendar year in which the report is submitted.
- (2) On or before July 15, 2020, and July 15 of each year thereafter, a person who issued a restricted ticket for an event scheduled during the reporting period shall submit a report described in Subsection (4) to the division.
- (3) On or before January 15, 2021, and January 15 of each year thereafter, a person who issued a restricted ticket for an event scheduled during the reporting period shall submit a report described in Subsection (4) to the division.
 - (4) A report submitted in accordance with this section shall contain the following information:
- (a) for each event scheduled during the reporting period and for which the person issued a restricted ticket:
 - (i) the total number of tickets the person issued for the event;
 - (ii) the number of restricted tickets the person issued for the event;
 - (iii) the date of the event;
 - (iv) the type of event; and
 - (v) the name of the venue where the event was scheduled to occur;
- (b) (i) for a report submitted in compliance with a July 15 deadline, the number of concert or theater events by venue scheduled during the reporting period; or
- (ii) for a report submitted in compliance with a January 15 deadline, the number of concert or theater events by venue scheduled during the preceding calendar year; and
- (c) the number of concert or theater events by venue scheduled during the reporting period for which the person issued a restricted ticket under Subsection 13-54-201(2)(b); and
 - (5) This section does not apply to an exempt entity.
