Senator Curtis S. Bramble proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 14:
  - 14 official { is entitled to } may request payment, by the state, of reasonable attorney fees and costs for
- 2. Page 2, Lines 31 through 38:
  - 31 (2) A respondent:
  - 32 (a) may, but is not required to, retain legal representation during the complaint review
  - 33 process; and
  - 34 (b) except as provided in Subsection (3), is responsible for payment of the respondent's
  - 35 attorney fees and costs incurred.
  - 36 (3) (a) If the commission determines that all allegations in the complaint are without merit,
  - 37 <u>the respondent</u> { <u>is entitled to payment, by the state,</u>} <u>may file a request with the Executive</u>

    <u>Appropriations Committee of the Legislature for the payment</u> <u>of reasonable attorney fees and costs for</u>
  - 38 <u>legal representation during the complaint review process.</u>
    - (b) If the Executive Appropriations Committee of the Legislature receives a request described in Subsection (3)(a), the Legislature may appropriate money to reimburse the respondent for some or all of the reasonable attorney fees and costs described in Subsection (3)(a).
