- (b) A substitute teacher hired through an employment agency, as described in Title 34, Chapter 29, Employment Agencies, shall receive from the school district or charter school in which the substitute will work, before employment as a substitute, the district's sensitivity training, including any training in a code of ethics or a code of conduct for teachers.
- (3) A teacher's position in the classroom may not be filled by an unlicensed substitute teacher for more than a total of 20 days during any school year unless licensed personnel are not available.
- (4) A person who is ineligible to hold a license for any reason other than professional preparation may not serve as a substitute teacher.
