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7   **LONG TITLE**

8   **General Description:**

9           This bill creates the Children's Health Care Coverage Program.

10 **Highlighted Provisions:**

11       This bill:

- 12           ▶ amends provisions relating to outreach to promote health insurance coverage for  
13 children;
- 14           ▶ creates the Children's Health Care Coverage Program;
- 15           ▶ describes the purposes of the program created in this bill;
- 16           ▶ creates the Children's Health Care Coverage Program Restricted Account; and
- 17           ▶ establishes a sunset date.

75           (B) any barriers during the application process;

76           (v) develop promotional material regarding CHIP and children's Medicaid eligibility,  
77 including outreach through social media, video production, and other media platforms;

78           (vi) identify ways that the eligibility website for enrollment in CHIP and children's  
79 Medicaid can be redesigned to increase accessibility and enhance the user experience;

80           (vii) identify outreach opportunities, including partnerships with community  
81 organizations including:

82           (A) schools;

83           (B) small businesses;

84           (C) unemployment centers;

85           (D) parent-teacher associations; and
